



# 2025 Interschools Eventing Series Rules and Procedures

*Equestrian WA is proud to announce the 2025 Saddles Plus Interschool Eventing Series held in conjunction with the Equestrian WA Interschool State Championship.*

## **SERIES**

The 2025 Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Series will be run over the following three (3) events:

- **Capel CCI**  
*15<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> March, Capel Regional Equestrian Centre, Capel WA*
- **WAYER CCI**  
*28<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> March, State Equestrian Centre, Brigadoon WA*
- **Murray CCN**  
*26<sup>th</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> April, Murray Regional Equestrian Centre, Coolup WA*

Riders must compete at two of the three events to qualify for the eventing series.

Awards will be given for EvAJ65 through to 2\*.

## **RULES**

Note: Students will be separated into primary and secondary school across the series.

Combinations will be placed in the championship series on their best two scores including penalties, of the competitions they complete, i.e. not eliminated, withdrawn or retired. If riders do not complete two or more competitions, they will not be included in the overall series results.

Riders in the EvA65 and EvA80 may either compete as an EA Participant member or EA Competitive Member. Riders in the EvA95 and above must be Competitive members and hold an eventing license. All eventing riders who compete at Interschool Nationals must be EA Competitive Members, no matter their level.

All combinations must nominate via Nominate

There is a flat fee of \$15 per combination, no matter how many events in the series they wish to ride in. Entries close on the 17<sup>th</sup> of March. All nominations must be received through the above Nominate link.

Riders competing at the 2\* Level, may compete in any of the following classes, the CCN2\*-S, CCI2\*-S and CCI2\*-L.

Riders are encouraged but not enforced to wear their school uniforms whilst competing. Both clothing options must comply with EA ruling.

There are no qualifiers required for the 2025 Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Series.

## SCORING

All scores will be calculated via the official results from each event. From these scores, the two lowest penalties will be averaged to decide who will win for their height in the series.

**ie. Capel= 28 penalties, WAYER= 67.3 penalties & Murray=33.2 penalties =30.6 penalties.**

Every score will be rounded to the second decimal point where applicable.

In the event where two riders have the same average score, the higher place will be determined by who attended the most events of the three available. If they are still the same, the higher place will be determined by who received the lowest penalties out of their completed events.

To be eligible for the series, riders must complete two events at the same height. Points and penalties will not be carried across heights.

### **Champion Event Rider Scoring**

The Champion Event Rider will be determined by which combination attended, and who scored the most points across all three events. Points will be allocated across the whole event placings per height, including those who have not nominated for the series. There will only be one (1) Champion Rider presented across all heights.

## AWARDS

- **Event Awards:**

Each event in the series will receive a rosette from 1<sup>st</sup> through to 6<sup>th</sup>. In the event where there are less than six (6) interschool riders, placings will be reduced. These scores are collected by the EWA Office from the Official Event Scores.

- **Series Awards:**

As according to the 'Series Rules' above, each height will be presented with the series winners from 1<sup>st</sup> through to 6<sup>th</sup> at the Interschools WA Awards Night. In the event where there are less than six (6) riders qualified for the series, placings will be reduced.

- **Champion Rider Award:**

As according to the 'Champion Rider' above, one rider will be awarded as the Overall Saddles Plus Interschools Eventing Rider. This will be presented at the Interschools WA Awards night.
