Subsidies to Clubs that run FEI events.

This grant is designed to meet the additional expenditure incurred when running an international event and is structured as follows:

MAXIMUM GRANT AMOUNT	HIGHEST LEVEL OFFERED
\$8000	CCI4*-L
\$6000	CCI3*-L
\$5000	CCI4*-S
\$3000	CCI3*-S
\$2500	CCI2*-S or L

OC's claiming this subsidy **may not** claim the Materials grant.

All Grants are paid through the Rider Levy.

Eventing WA are working on behalf of all riders to ensure sustainability of the sport.

GUIDELINES - Funding from Eventing Development Funds

Funding may be granted for:

- Building materials for cross country obstacles.
- Building materials for construction of sheds.
- Showjumping equipment.
- Dressage equipment.
- Improvement/upgrading canteen and food preparation facilities.
- Upgrade of toilet/shower facilities.
- Airfare for Officials
- Airfare for accredited course designer of FEI/judge
- Accommodation for officials.
- Hire car for officials.
- Hire of equipment (this may be a maximum of a total of 50% total of the grant).
- At the discretion of the committee funds may be made available to clubs or person in extenuating circumstances in relation to the benefit of the industry.







WESTERN AUSTRALIA

- 1. Clubs and Associations must be fully paid affiliated members of Equestrian WA
- 2. All outstanding fees and levies MUST be paid prior to being eligible for funds.
- 3. The Eventing WA Equipment Trailer register, must be completed in full and returned to Eventing WA. The trailer must be returned to the State Equestrian Centre, or delivered as arranged with the next venue, the Wednesday after the event.
- 4. Only EWA and/or FEI approved courses are eligible for funding and the event must have been run in accordance with all safety and medical requirements.
- 5. Clubs or Associations must have a lease or written agreement regarding Tenure of Land if applying for materials grant if the Intend to build any permanent structure ie shed, abutilons, cross country jumps. If no lease or written agreement of Tenure of Land is available, all structures built with grant money must be demountable and fully transportable ie able to be totally removed if the land is sold, or the club or association is no longer able to conduct Official EWA events on that property.
- 6. If the Club is no longer able to conduct EWA events, all demountable property constructed with Grant funds, becomes the property of Eventing WA, to distribute to like Clubs conducting EWA events in the following order: the immediate locality, region or State respectively.
- 7. Only those clubs who confirm their dates and classes in the year prior will be eligible for these grants (as any changes during the year may not have been budgeted for).
- 8. Subsidies must be claimed for WITHIN 3 months of the event.
